Included in her communication responsibilities are newsletter and video creation, and social media promotion of the work being done in Peru. She also assists with other communications tasks as needed.

Nichelle's hometown is New Plymouth, Idaho, where her home congregation of Immanuel Lutheran Church is located. She received an associate's degree in graphic design from

the Art Institute of Pittsburgh (online division) and a bachelor's degree in finance from Boise State University, Boise, Idaho. Before serving in Peru, Nichelle worked as a marketing coordinator, graphic designer, home stager and interior designer. In 2016, she participated on a short-term mission team to Nicaragua. Her hobbies include reading, painting, kayaking, hiking, traveling, weight lifting and running.
